Middlesex Co. Town of Sudbury June 1st 1835.
Pursuant to the within warrant I have notified the inhabitants
of the town of Sudbury herein described to meet at said time
and place and for the purposes within mentioned by posting
up an attested copy of this warrant at the public meeting house
in said town two Sabbaths before the time of said meeting -
Daniel H. Moore Constable of Sudbury.

At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury
held on Monday the first day of June A. D. 1835 the articles
in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon in
the following manner.

1. The vote for two County Commissioners were for the follow-
ing persons Joseph Butterfield Kingsbury two votes.

Abner Wheeler Framingham thirty three votes.

David Townsend Waltham nineteen votes

John Wade Webster four votes.

Stephen Pope Marlborough thirty seven votes.

Luke Fish Waltham one vote

Edmund Parker two votes.

For Special Commissioner

William Livingston Lowell thirty eight votes

Stephen Pope Marlborough one vote.

Edmund Parker one vote.

2. Chose Drury Fairbank Moderator.

3. Voted to pass over this article.

Then voted that this meeting be dissolved.
