

August 21st 1835.

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At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the thirty first day of August D. 1835 the articles of the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner.

1. Chose Samuel Jones Moderator.
2. Voted to pass over this article.
3. Voted to accept of the following Report

Sudbury August 31st 1835

Your Committee appointed at a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the 6th day of April D. 1835 have attended that service and beg leave to report as follows that we have been on to Brimstone Lane and Mr. Adam Howe claims all but about one hundred & forty rods; and that he should like to purchase. And there is another small piece at the east end of the burying yard and that is all within our knowledge which we humbly submit to the Town for their Consideration.

Then voted to call on Mr. Wheeler Haynes to make an offer for the piece of land east of the burying Ground (Mr. Haynes came forward and offered fifty Dollars p. acre for the land) Then voted to accept of Mr. Haynes offer provided the Committee and Mr. Haynes can agree upon the bounds and quantity of land. Then voted that so much of the above Report as respects Brimstone Lane be recommitted to the Committee to report at a future meeting. Then voted that this meeting be dissolved.
