L.S. Middlebury Co. To Daniel W. Moore Constable of the town of
L.S. Sudbury in the County of Middlebury Greeting.

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are directed to notify the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at the public meeting house in said Sudbury on Monday the ninth day of November next at one o'clock in the afternoon then and there to act on the following articles.

1. To choose a Moderator.
2. To see if the town will accept of a road as laid out by the Selectmen on the Petition of Levi Smith & others.
3. To see if the town will receive any part of the money belonging to the Ministerial Fund of the Trustees and appropriate it to the payment of the towns debts.
4. To see if the town will take any measures to dispose of their Poor Establishment.
5. To see if the town will discount certain Taxes to Willard Maynard.
6. To hear and act on all Reports of Committees that may be offered.
7. To see if the town will take any measures to move the Centre School-House or act any way on this article as the town shall think best.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested Copy thereof at the public meeting house in said town two Sabbaths at least before the time for holding said meeting. Hereof fail not and make due return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the town Clerk at the time and place of meeting as aforesaid. Given under our hands and Seals this 29th day of Oct.
