

November 2. 1835.

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At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the 9th day of Nov. A. D. 1835 the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner.

1. Chose William Brigham Moderator.
2. Voted to pass over this article.
3. Voted to pass over this article.
4. Voted to pass over this article.
5. Voted to pass over all papers presented to be discounted.
6. Voted to accept of the following Report.

Sudbury Nov. 10th 1835 The town of Sudbury Dr.
To Ephraim Moore for making Road as laid out by
the Selectmen and accepted by the town of Sudbury
from the Berlin Road to land of said Moore
which is \$35.00

which I present for acceptance.

Then voted to pass over this article for the present.

7. Voted that if there is any individual or individuals in town who will move the Centre school house within a week under the direction of a Committee of the town that they have leave then voted to choose a committee of seven then chose Luther Goodnow, Dwyn Fairbanks, William Brigham, John Hunt, C. G. Cutler, Eddy Fairbanks & Daniel Pepper. then voted to choose one in addition and chose Martin Brown - then voted to instruct this Committee provided the school house is moved that it be done without any expense to the town and left in as good repair as it is at present.

Then took up the 6. Article and voted to accept of the following Report Your Committee further report as follows that there is about an acre of the land left for a two rod way between Mr. William Smith's & Daniel Bowker's land that is not sold.

Sudbury Nov. 9th 1835. A. Goodnow Chairman of S. D. Committee.
Then voted that said Committee be directed to sell the land reported and pass Deeds of the same - then voted that this meeting be dissolved.
