

March 9. 1836

2. Votes for County Treasurer were for
Timothy Prescott seventy seven votes,
John Meyer seventeen votes.

3. Votes for Register of Deeds were for
William F. Stone forty eight votes.
Timothy Prescott one vote.

4. Voted to repair their highways in the same manner as the
last year and to allow the same for labour which was 12 1/2
cts. per hour. then voted that their highway Surveyors be
collectors. Then granted twelve hundred Dollars to
repair their highways.

5. Put over to April meeting.

6. Chose as a Committee on Accounts Deuben Moore
John Jones & Daniel Puffer

7. Voted to accept of the report of the Ministerial Fund
Corporation and order the same to be recorded.

Agreeable to an act of the Legislature of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
passed June 14th 1817 Establishing a Ministerial Fund in the
town of Sudbury making it the duty of the Trustees thereof to
make a report to said town showing the state of said Fund
with their doings thereon at the annual meeting in March
or April agreeable to said act said Trustees do leave to
report as follows the Funded Sum amounting to three
thousand two hundred Dollars and ninety four Cents
Consisting of promissory Notes ^{of record} interest to be paid annually
the 30th of August the interest arising from the above
funded sum which was due August 30th 1835 amounting
to the sum of One hundred & ninety two Dollars and five Cents
the Treasurer has since collected and paid the Peter Rufus Murlatt
by order of said Trustees agreeable to said act of incorporation
all which is humbly submitted by Levi Dakin } Committee
