129/ To Daniel W. Moore Constable of the town of
Sudbury in the County of Middlesex Greeting.

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in elections and in town affairs to meet at the Public Meeting-house in said Sudbury on Monday the fourth day of April next at one o'clock in the afternoon Then and there to act on the following articles

1. To Choose a Moderator.
2. To choose a town treasurer & Constable and fill all vacancies in the town officers.
3. To act on the 5, 9, & 11 article in the warrant for March meeting which were put over to April meeting - and to act on so much of the 8 article in said warrant as was put over to April meeting.
4. To see if the town will accept of the Settlement of the Selectmen with the town Treasurer and order the same to be recorded.
5. To grant money for the Summer & Winter Schools and order how the same shall be distributed.
6. To grant money for the support of the Poor the present year and to grant money to pay for their Poor Establishment if the town shall think proper.
7. To grant money to pay the Horses the present year.
8. To grant money to pay the town Treasurer the present year.
9. To grant money to pay accounts allowed by the Committee on accounts.
10. To grant or appropriate money to pay those soldiers who may be entitled to draw money from the treasury the present year and appropriate money to pay a balance due the soldiers last year.
11. To hear and act on all Reports of Committees that may be offered.
12. To see if the town will appoint some person to ring the bell for town meetings and act as deacon the present year.
