13. To see if the town will grant or appropriate money to purchase a number of Ploughs to be used on the highways.
14. To see if the town will borrow any money of the Trustees of the Ministerial Fund to pay a part of what the town owes Mr. Asa Hoyer.
15. To see if the town will agree to pay Mr. Joseph Abbott six per. ct. for the money on which they paid him five per. ct. for the last year or borrow the money and pay him.
16. To see if the town will appropriate thirty five Dollars out of any money now in the treasury to pay Col. Ephraim Moore for building a road leading by Daniel W. Moore's.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested Copy thereof at the public meeting-house in said town two Sabbaths at least before the time for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the town Clerk at the time and place of meeting as aforesaid.
