

April 9. 1836.

At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the 4th day of April A. D. 1836 the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner.

1. Chose John Hunt Moderator.

2. Chose Drury Fairbank town Treasurer, voted to put over the choice of Constable untill after the choice of Collector; then chose Levi Dean Highway Surveyor instead of Cyrus Hunt who refused to serve - then chose Webster Cutting Highway Surveyor instead of Henry Vose who declined serving - then chose Abel Dakin Jr. Highway Surveyor instead of Wm. Stone who declined serving. - then chose Asa Jones on the school Committee instead of Wm. Brigham who declined serving. - then chose Silas Willis Highway Surveyor instead of Webster Cutting who declined serving.

3. Agreed with Doct. Thomas Stearns to collect the Taxes the present year for one & seven eighths p. ct. - Then voted to choose a Committee to examine the Canal Bridge & the Bridge near Adam Howes and to report at the next town meeting. Then chose Luther Goodman Lyman Howe & Drury Fairbank. Then voted to discount to the Collector Abigail Duttons Tax 86 Cents & Luther S. Phipps Tax \$1.41. Then voted to take up the 2nd article & chose Daniel W. Moore Constable. - Then voted to take up the 3rd article and voted (with the consent of Thomas Stearns) to reconsider the vote agreeing with Doctor Thomas Stearns to collect the Taxes for one & 7/8 p. ct. Then voted to give Daniel W. Moore two p. ct. for collecting the Taxes the year ensuing.

4. Voted to put over the settlement with the town Treasurer to the next town meeting.

5. Granted four Hundred Dollars for the Winter Schools to be equally divided among the five school Districts - then granted fifty five Dollars for Wood to be equally divided among the five school Districts - then granted two hundred Dollars for the summer schools to be equally divided among the five school Districts - then granted fifteen Dollars for the small school house in the west part of the town.
