6. Voted to grant One thousand Dollars 500 for the support of the Poor and 500 towards paying for the farm - Then voted to reconsider the former vote. And granted \$1000, for the support of the Poor and what is not wanted for the support of the Poor to go towards paying for the Poor farm - Then granted five hundred Dollars towards paying for the Poor farm.

7. Granted fifteen Dollars to pay the Assessors.

8. Granted ten Dollars to pay the town Treasurer.

9. Granted to pay Amounts allowed by the Committee on a/c, nineteen Dollars & ninety Cents
