Pursuant to the within warrant I have notified the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury therein described to meet at said time & place and for said purposes within mentioned by posting upon an attached copy of this warrant at the public meeting house in said town two Sabbaths before the time set for holding said meeting.

At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the thirtieth day of May A.D. 1836 the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner viz.

1. Chose John Hunt Moderator.
2. Voted to accept of the Settlement of the Selectmen with the town Treasurer and ordered the same to be recorded (recorded forward)
3. Chose Benjamin Smith to fill the vacancy in the school Committee
4. Granted thirty five Dollars to Col. Ephraim Moore for making a road from the County road to his house, — and \$104. for making the road laid out by the Selectmen on the petition of Col. Ephraim Moore and others.
5. Voted to divide forty Dollars of the money received from the State school fund equally among the five school Districts & the remaining three Dollars 21¢ to the small District in the west part of the town.
6. Voted to discount to the Collector the following Taxes viz.
Josiah H. Adams \$2.75. Charles Brigham \$1.41. Alexander Winter \$1.41. Mchitable Jones \$2.08. Josiah Richardson one pole \$1.41. and Lewis Moore one pole \$1.41.
