7. Voted to accept of a road laid out by the Selectmen on the Petition of Joel Moore and others as follows.

We the subscribers Selectmen of the town of Sudbury have laid out for the use of the town a town way as follows, Beginning at a Stake & Stones on the South side of the County road leading from the Meeting house to Asa Jones at land of John P. Allen then through said Allen's land south four rods to a Stake & Stone then Southwesterly across Joel Moore's land thirteen and a half rods to a Stake & Stone at the old road - the road laid out on the west side of the bounds two rods wide. And we have allowed the several owners of the land for their damages to John P. Allen one Dollar to Joel Moore five Dollars. William Brigham

Your Committee chosen on Monday the 20th day of April A.D. 1835 to let out the making of the road located by the selectmen on the Petition of Ephraim Moore & others have attended the duty assigned them and report that they have let out the two Bridges & Causeway to Joel Parmenter for the sum of \$75.00 Also the making of the road to Obadiah Perry, for the sum of 26.00
