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To Daniel H. Moore Constable of the town of Sudbury
in the County of Middlesex

Greeting
In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you
are directed to notify the inhabitants of the town of Sud-
bury qualified to vote in elections to meet at the public
Meeting-house in said Sudbury on Monday the four-
teenth day of Nov. current being the second Monday
of said month at 12 o'clock meridian.

To bring in to the selectmen their votes for a Governor
and Lieut Governor of this Commonwealth and for
five Senators on one Ballot for the District of Middle-
sex for the year ensuing.

And to bring in their votes for a Representative of said Com-
monwealth in the Congress of the United States for Dis-
trict Number four.

And to choose a Representative to represent them in
the General Court of this Commonwealth to be convened &
holden at Boston on the first Wednesday of Jan. next.

And to bring in their votes for Electors of President
and Vice President of the United States.

And to bring in their votes for or against the pro-
posed Article of Amendment to the Constitution
submitted to the people by a Resolve of the General
Court approved by the Governor April 1st 1836.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting
up an attested Copy thereof at the public Meeting-
house in said Sudbury two Sabbaths at least before
the time for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this warrant
with your doings thereon to ourselves at the time and
place of Meeting as aforesaid.
