11. To say if the town will authorize the Selectmen to employ a physician to inoculate with the true pox all the inhabitants of the town who may choose to be inoculated.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the public Meeting-house in said Sudbury two Sabbaths at least before the time for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your doings thereon to ourselves at the time & place of meeting as aforesaid.
