At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the sixth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner.

1. The whole number of Ballots given in for a County Commissioner were ninety six and were for Edmund Parker forty seven votes

Joel Fuller forty seven votes

Asijah Goodrich two votes

Then voted that this meeting be dissolved
