

April D. 1837.

At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the third day of April D. 1837 the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner

1. The whole number of votes given in for a County Commission were one hundred & thirty and were for Timothy Fletcher eighty one votes  
Edmund Parker forty nine votes

William Maynard } Sudbury

Then voted that this meeting be dissolved

2. Chose John Hunt Moderator.
3. Chose Silly Smith town Treasurer, choice of Constable put over for the present, then chose John Hunt Highway Surveyor instead of Leander Haynes excused - Then voted to excuse Timothy A. Stone from serving as highway surveyor, then chose Edward Brown in his stead, then chose Thaddeus Fowler on the School Committee instead of Joseph Smith excused.
4. Then took up the 5 article in the warrant for March meeting which was put over to April meeting and voted to collect the Taxes in the usual manner the same as last year. then agreed with Joseph Smith to collect the taxes for one and five eighths per. ct. Then took up the 3rd article and chose Daniel M. Moore Constable. Then took up the 7th article in the warrant for March meeting which was put over to April meeting and voted to discount to the Collector the following Taxes Josiah Moores for 1835 \$2.76: for 1836 \$2.33. Sumner Sampson's \$1.41: Henry Vase Jr. \$0.37: James M. Parmenter \$1.24.
5. Voted to accept of the Settlement of the Selectmen with the town's treasurer and ordered the same to be recorded as follows
