L. G. Middlesex Co. To Daniel H. Moore Constable of the town of Sudbury
 L. G. in the county of Middlesex

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at the public meeting house in said town on Monday the fifteenth day of May current at one o'clock in the afternoon then and there to act on the following articles

1. To Choose a Moderator.
2. To consider and determine whether the town will agree to receive its proportion of the monies received & to be received by the Treasurer and Receiver General of this Commonwealth from the Secretary of the Treasury of the United States for deposit with this Commonwealth in pursuance with an act of Congress entitled an Act to regulate the deposits of the public money approved on the 23^d day of June in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty six and will comply with the terms and provisions contained in the several Acts of this Commonwealth concerning the deposits of the Surplus Revenue. And to see if the town will appropriate the money to discharge any of the towns debts.
3. To see if the town will accept of a road as laid out by the Selectmen through land of David Haynes and the Poor Farm.
4. To hear and act on all Reports of Committees that may be offered.
5. To see if the town will discount to Daniel H. Moore certain Taxes
6. To see if the town will appropriate the money arising from the State school fund.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the public meeting house in said Sudbury two Sabbaths at least before the time for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the town Clerk at the time and place of meeting as aforesaid.
