At a meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury duly notified according to law and holden in said town on the fifteenth day of May in the year 1837 for the purpose of considering and determining whether said town would agree to receive its proportion of the monies received & to be received, by the Treasurer and Receiver General of this Commonwealth, from the Secretary of the Treasury of the United States, for deposit with this Commonwealth, in pursuance of an Act of Congress, entitled an Act to regulate the Deposit of the Public Money, approved on 23^d June, 1836, and will comply with the terms & provisions contained in the several Acts of this Commonwealth, concerning the deposit of the Surplus Revenue, it was Voted, that this town agree to receive, from the Treasurer & Receiver General of the Commonwealth, its proportion of the Surplus Revenue of the United States, in deposit, and will comply with the terms and provisions of the several Acts, passed by the Legislature of said Commonwealth, concerning the deposit of the Surplus Revenue. Voted that the Treasurer Pelly Smith be the agent of this town, for the purpose of receiving from the Treasurer and Receiver General of this Commonwealth, this town's proportion of the said Revenue in deposit. Voted that the Treasurer Pelly Smith agent, as aforesaid, be, and he hereby is, authorised to sign a certificate of deposit, for the sums of money he may receive, from time to time, from the said Treasurer and receiver General of this Commonwealth, binding the town, in its corporate capacity, for the repayment, to said Treasurer, of the money so deposited with this town, and any & every part thereof, whenever the same shall be required by said Treasurer and Receiver General, to be by him refunded to the Secretary of the Treasury of the United States. Then Voted to appropriate the money to be received as above to pay the towns debts.
