Voted that the forsaide Committee be authorized to go on and build the bridge with Stone as recommended: Then voted to grant One hundred Dollars to rebuild said bridge.

Voted to accept of the Report of Wm. Brigham one of the Selectmen as follows. The town of Sudbury to Wm. Brigham Dr.

To 7 Guide Boards \$2.33

To painting & lettering the same 4.90

To Nails 0.14

To one Guide Post 1.00

To putting up the boards on the Posts 0.75 \$9.12

Sudbury May 13th 1837.

Then appropriated nine Dollars 12/00 to pay said Bill out of any unappropriated money in the Treasury.

5. Voted to discount to Daniel W. Moore Collector the following Taxes Charles Brigham \$1.24: Rufus Brigham \$1.24, Saml. B. B. \$1.24: Eliza Gasfield \$1.24. Abigail Dutton \$0.73: Daphin Osborn \$0.56.

6. Voted to appropriate the money for winter schools to be equally divided among the five school Districts.

Then voted that this meeting be dissolved.
