L.S. Middlesex Co. To Daniel W. Moore Constable of the town
 of Sudbury in the County of Middlesex -- Greeting.

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are directed to notify the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at the public Meeting-house in said Sudbury on Thursday the twenty ninth day of June current at two o'clock in the afternoon then and there to act on the following articles.

1. To choose a Moderator.

2. To see what measures the town will take relative to an order of notice from the County Commissioners on the petition of Eschail Parmenter and others for a new highway in the southwest part of the town, to do or act any way on this article as the town may think proper.

3. To see what measures the town will take relative to a suit commenced by the inhabitants of the town of Hubbardston against the inhabitants of Sudbury for the expense of the last sickness & funeral charges of Rebekah Muddall, to do or act any way on this article as the town shall think proper.

4. To see if the town will give the Treasurer any further instructions respecting the receiving the first and second installments of the Surplus Revenue to do or act any way on this article as the town shall think proper.

5. To see if the town will discontinue the road from the old Graves House to the Worcester road at Edward H. Gibbs.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the public Meeting-house in said Sudbury two Sabbaths at least before the time for holding said meeting.
