Pursuant to the within warrant I have notified the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury herein described to meet at said time & place and for the purposes within mentioned by posting up an attested copy of this warrant at the public meeting house in said Sudbury two Sabbaths before the time set for holding said meeting

At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the thirtieth day of Dec. 1837 the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner.

1. Chose John Hunt Moderator.

2. Voted to Choose a Committee to let out the making of the road located on the petition of Calvin C. Vernon and others. Then chose Drury Fairbanks, Charles Garry, Timothy Johnson, Daniel Tupper & Abel B. Jones. Then voted that the Committee promise to pay for making said road one half at the first instalment of taxes in 1838 & the other half at the second instalment.

3. Voted to build a Barn on the Poor Establishment - then voted to Choose a Committee of three to superintend the building of said Barn. Then chose William Brigham, Samuel Jones & Preben Haynes. Then voted that the Committee be authorised to build said Barn ready for use before next haying time either by contract or otherwise.

4. Voted to pass over this article

5. No Reports offered.

6. Voted to appropriate three dollars & 75 cts out of the surplus of 1837 to pay an outstanding Order to Daniel H. Moore.
