

March 1838.

At a legal meeting of the Inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs held on Monday the fifth day of March A.D. 1838. The Articles in the preceding warrant were acted upon in the following manner, to wit:

1. Chose John Hunt Moderator, Then chose for Town Clerk Thomas Stearns who was qualified in open townmeeting by Nahum Thompson Esq. Selectmen Timothy Johnson, William Maynard, Abel B. Jones, Charles Perry and Martin Brown. Treasurer and Constable, - choice of put over to April meeting.

Assessors Abel B. Jones, John Jones, Drury Fairbanks School Committee put over to April Meeting.

Overseers of the Poor, Samuel Jones, John Hunt Aaron Hunt.

Fish-wardens, Levi Smith, S. N. Bowker, Nahum Parmenter.

Fence-Viewers, Aaron Johnson, Israel Haynes Lewis Brigham.

Field Drivers Aaron Johnson, Levi Smith, S. N. Bowker. Asa Hayes, James Quin, Lewis Moore.

Tything Men, Rufus Hulbut, Levi Smith, John Hunt, Joel Dakin, Loring Wheeler.

Surveyors of Lumber, Edward Fisher Jeremiah Flint, Samuel Jones.

Clerks of the Market, Enoch Kiader Lyman Howe Pound Keeper Asher Goodnow Junr.

Surveyors of Highways, Crosby Carr, Joseph Smith Jason Bent Joel Dakin, Loring Eaton, David Lincoln, John Brown Isaac Parmenter, Thomas L. Dakin, Jonathan^r Voss.

Then the town acted on the fifth Article in said Warrant and chose for Committee on Accounts, William Brigham Daniel Puffer, Aaron Hunt - Then voted that the remaining Articles be put over to April meeting, and the meeting be dissolved.
