9. To see if the town will discount certain taxes, which may be laid before them for that purpose.
10. To see if the town will accept of a map of the public lands belonging to the Commonwealth, and direct how it shall be disposed of.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the public meeting house in said Sudbury two sabbaths at least before the time for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your doings thereon to ourselves at the time and place of said meeting as aforesaid.
