Greeting

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at the public meeting house in said Sudbury on Monday the sixteenth day of April instant at one o'clock P.M. then & there to act on the following articles, to wit:

1. To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting.
2. To act on the ninth Article in the warrant of March meeting and on the 4th 6th and seventh Articles in the warrant for April meeting, which will be put over to a future meeting.
3. To see if the town will accept of the settlement of the Selectmen with the Treasurer and order the same to be recorded.
4. To Grant a suitable sum of money for the Winter and Summer Schools, and order how the same shall be distributed.
5. To grant money for the support of the poor the present year.
6. To grant money for the payment of the Assessors the present year.
7. To grant money to pay the treasurer the present year.
8. To grant money to pay accounts allowed by the Committee on accounts and incidental expenses.
9. To hear and act on all reports of committees that may be offered.
10. To see if the town will appropriate the money, assessed upon the American Powder Company & their tenants for public schools, to the use of the school in Acton near said Company's works, to enable said Company and tenants to send their children to said school in Acton.
11. To see if the town will grant money for the support of a singing school, and choose a committee to lay out the same.
