Warrant for town meeting April 16th Continued

12. To see if the town will alter the time for the payments of taxes - to do or act as the town shall think proper
13. To see if the town will authorize their treasurer to borrow a sum of money sufficient to pay certain debts of the town.
14. To discount certain taxes that may be offered for that purpose -

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up at the public meetinghouse in Sudbury an attested copy thereof, two sabbaths at least before the time for holding said meeting -

Hereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the town clerk at the time of meeting as aforesaid -
