In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Sudbury qualified to vote for Representatives to the General Court, and in town affairs, to meet at the public meeting house in said Sudbury on Monday the seventh day of May next at three o'clock P.M. then and there to act on the following articles, to wit,

1. To bring in to the Selectmen their written votes on one ticket for two County Commissioners, inhabitants of different towns in said County, and also for one Special Commissioner.
2. To Choose a Moderator
3. To see if the town will take any measures to straighten the line between Sudbury and Wayland and choose a Committee for that purpose —
4. To see if the town will take any measures to pay Henry Vose & Lewis Bingham for land taken into the high way in making a straightening in the road near the Iron Works causeway — (Causd forward)
