3. To see what measures the town will take in regard to a road prayed for in the petition of Abner Parmelee and others.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at said public meeting house in said town two sabbaths at least before the time for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the selectmen at the time and place aforesaid
