to notify and warn the Inhabitants of said Town qualified
to vote for representatives to the General Court to meet
at the public meeting house in said Sudbury on
Monday the sixteenth day of July inst. at four o'clock
P.M. then & there to act on the following Articles
to wit:-

1. To bring in the selectmen their written votes for a
special commissioner for said County
2. To choose a moderator
3. To see if the town will take any measures to
procure the release of Benjamin Pice from the
Lunatic Hospital at Worcester to do or act
as the town may think proper.

And you are directed to serve
this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof
at the public meeting house in said Sudbury, two
Sabbaths at least before the time for holding said
meeting.

Hereof fail not and make
due return of this warrant with your doings thereon
to the selectmen at the time and place aforesaid
