 L.S. the town of Sudbury in said County — Greeting.
 L.S. In the name of the Commonwealth of Massa-
 L.S. chusetts, You are hereby required to notify and warn
 the Inhabitants of said town qualified to vote for Representatives
 to the General Court, to meet at the Public meeting house in
 said town, on Monday the seventeenth day of December instant
 at twelve o'clock M. to give in their votes to the Selectmen for
 one Representative that is an inhabitant of District number four
 to represent said District in the Congress of the United States.
 — And also to act on the following Articles viz —
 1. To Choose a Moderator —
 2. To see if the town will take any measures to make the
 road laid out by the Selectmen through land of David
 Haynes and the Poor Farm, To do or act &c —
 3. To see if the town will accept of a highway laid out by the
 Selectmen on the petition of John Brown and others.
 4. To see if the town will accept of a highway laid out by the
 Selectmen on the petition of Beriah Oaks and others —
 5. To see if the town will accept of a highway laid out by the
 Selectmen on the petition of Noah Smith and two others —
 6. To hear and act on reports of committees that may be
 offered —
 7. To see if the Town will authorize the owners of the poor
 to build a shed adjoining to the new barn on the poor
 farm, and remove the cider mill house, To do or act as
 the town shall think proper —
 8. To see if the town will take any measures to enlarge their
 burying ground —
 9. To see if the town will compensate Mr. Obadiah Perry for
 land taken for a road, and for fencing on said road.
 And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up
 an attested copy thereof at the public meeting house in said
 town two sabbaths at least before the time for holding said
 meeting —
