Pursuant to the within warrant I have notified and warned the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury as within directed -

Daniel M. Moore Constable of Sudbury

At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury held on Monday the seventeenth day of December A.D. 1838 - The said inhabitants gave in their votes for a Representative to represent District number four, in the Congress of the United States, as follows

Whole number of ballots was one hundred and ninety five
For Hon. William Parmenter one hundred and sixteen votes
" " Nathan Brooks - Sixty votes
" " Amos Farnsworth Three votes
" " James T. Woodbury two votes
" " Levi Farwell - Ten votes
" " Henry M. Chamberlain two votes
" " Nahum Harwood two votes -

The town then proceeded to act on the Articles of the Warrant as follows.

1. Chose Col. D. Fairbanks Moderator.
2. Voted to put over this Article till after the fifth Act.
