3. To act upon the 3. 4. 5. 6. 7. & 8.th articles of the warning of the meeting in November last, and the 3.^d article of the warning of December meeting
4. To see if the town will sell or otherwise dispose of the wood standing on the old way leading from Berlin road to Willis Pond, to do or act &c.
5. To see if the town will discount certain taxes that may be offered for that purpose.
6. To hear and act upon all reports that may be offered
7. To Grant a suitable sum of money for repairing highways, town ways and Bridges the present year
8. To see if the town will now district the town to do or act any way that the town may think proper

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the meeting house aforesaid two sabbaths at least before the time for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this warrant with you doings thereon to the town clerk at the time and place for holding said meeting.
