In the name of the Commonwealth of

Massachusetts you are hereby required

to notify and warn the inhabitants of the
Town of Sudbury, qualified to vote for

Representatives to the General Court to meet at the meet-
ing house of the first Parish in said Sudbury on Mon-
day the first day of April next at twelve o'clock M. then
and there to give in to the Selectmen their written votes
for a representative for Congressional District Number four,
to represent said District in the Congress of the United
States. And you are also directed to warn the inhab-
itants of said town qualified to vote in town affairs to
meet at the time and place aforesaid to act on the
following Articles viz

1. To Choose a Moderator
2. To Choose a County Treasurer
3. To Grant a suitable sum of money for the support
of the poor the ensuing year
4. To Grant money for the payment of accounts all-
owed by the committee on accounts
5. To Grant money for the support of schools, and
order how the same shall be distributed
6. To Grant money to pay the treasurer and Assessors.
7. To Grant money to pay Silas Conant, Gardner Hunt
and Abel Dakin for land and fencing.
8. To Grant money to pay Obadiah Perry for land and
fencing.
9. To hear and act on all reports of committees.
10. To fill all vacancies in town and County offices
11. To see if the town will amend the vote, taken on the
highway at March meeting to do or act as the town
shall think proper.
