12. To see if the town will choose a committee to let out the making of the roads laid out by the selectmen and grant money to pay for the same
13. To see if the town will grant money to defray the expense of cutting monuments between Sudbury and wayland
14. To grant money for incidental expenses
15. To see if the town will grant an extra sum of money to repair the south road
16. To see if the town will choose an agent or agents to meet the commissioners, on the petition of Amory Holman, John Eaton and others.
17. To see if the town will build a shed on the poor farm.
18. To see if the town will discount certain taxes.
19. To see if the town will petition the Postmaster General to discontinue the two post offices, now established, and establish one in the center of the town.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the meeting house of the aforesaid First Parish two sabbaths at least before the time for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your doings thereon to ourselves, at, or before the time for holding said meeting.
