5th Granted the sum of two hundred & fifteen dollars to be distributed as it was last year for Sum^r Schools For Winter School four hundred dollars to be equally distributed -

Granted sixty dollars for firewood for schools to be equally distributed among the five S. Districts -

6. Granted ten dollars ^{to pay the Treasurer} & twenty dollars for Assessors

Voted to pass over the 7th Art and take up the 8th -

Voted not to grant the sum expressed in this Article -

7. Voted grant the sum of one hundred & three dollars for the purposes expressed in said Article

9. Voted to accept the report of the Committee on the mile bridge, & granted eight dollars & 44/100 to pay the balance due as for report. -

Voted to accept the report of the committee on the two road highway leading from Berlin road to Miller Pond.

Voted to accept of the report of the overseers of the poor -

10. As Mr Goddard Esq declining to serve as overseers of poor, Cep^r Reuben Puffer was chosen to that office Livi Parmente Jun. declining to serve as highway Surveyor, Abel Parmente Jun was chosen in his stead.

11. Voted to make the surveyors collectors & the price of labor 10 cents an hour. in each highway district. -

12. Voted to choose a committee of three for the purposes expressed in this Article, and granted the sum of twenty five dollars ^{Cutter, Tim^r Johnson & David Lincoln were chosen} to defray the expense - and C. G.

13. Voted to pass over this Article -
