Chose Drury Fairbank Moderator

Voted to take up the 5th Article, and chose the overseers of the poor together with Ephraim Moon & John Jones a committee to investigate the subject of said Article and report at the adjourned meeting -

Voted to adjourn to the 25th inst. at one o'clock P.M.

Sudbury Nov. 25th 1839 - The town having met according to adjournment, and the committee on the account of Webster Moon reported verbally that the said moon would make no deduction from his account, When upon - Voted to commit the subject with directions to the Committee to make a tender or settle at their discretion -

2^d Article was taken up and Capt Wm. Rice Chosen agent to oppose the location of the road mentioned in said Article

3. Article Voted to pass over it -

4. Article Voted to accept the report of the committee on the Papumill road and order the same to be recorded -

Voted to discount the taxes of Guy S. Bumoughs \$ 1. 27 - and Joseph Goodnow - 1. 20 -

The Committee chosen Nov. 13th 1837. To make or cause to be made the road located on the petition of Calvin C Damon and others have attended to that service and ask leave to report The whole expense of making said road together with the railing amounts to the sum of three hundred and sixty eight dollars, which sum has been granted, assessed and paid out to the contractors for making said road - The County Commissioners have examined said road and accepted the same -
