 / L.S. In the Name of the Commonwealth of Massachu-
 / L.S. -setts, you are hereby required to notify and warn
 / L.S. the inhabitants of said Town qualified to vote
 in town affairs to meet at the Meetinghouse of the first
 Parish in said Town, on Monday the second day of March
 next at 12 o'clock M. then and there to act on the following
 Articles, viz.

1. To Choose a moderator
2. To bring in their votes for a County Treasurer.
3. To Choose all necessary Town Officers for the ensuing year
4. To see what measures the town will take to repair their
highways & bridges the ensuing year and grant a suit-
-able sum of money for that purpose.
5. To Choose a committee on accounts.
6. To hear and act upon all reports of committees.
7. To see if the town will accept of a way laid out by
the Selectmen, and discontinue a certain piece of Town
-way leading from the highway, near Noah Smith's to
Abraham Smith's
8. To see if the town will discount certain taxes that
may be offered for that purpose.
9. To see if the Town will repair the town house and
furnish a new pall to do or act.
10. To see if the Town new district or Establish the school
districting system to do or act any way so that
there shall be an equal distribution of the school
money
11. To see if the Town will take any measures to
-rebuild the Poor establishment house, to do or act
upon the subject matter of this article as they shall
think proper.
