 L. S. In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts,
 you are hereby required to notify and
 warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury quali-
 fied to vote in town affairs to meet at the meeting-
 house of the first Parish in said Town on Monday
 the twenty third instant at three o'clock P.M. to act
 on the following Articles, viz,

1. To choose a Moderator.
2. To choose a Committee to let out the making of
 the repairs ordered by the Commissioners to be made
 on the north road, so called, in said Town - and
 also to choose a committee to let out the making
 of a road located on the petition of John Eaton
 and others.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by post-
 ing up an attested copy thereof at the meeting house
 aforesaid two sabbaths at least before the time for
 holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this warrant
 with your doings thereon to ourselves at or before the
 time for holding said meeting.
