13. To see if the town will take any measures to recover certain records which have been taken from the Clerks office, and not returned - And also to repair some books, containing the ancient records of said town, To do or act &c.
14. To see if the town will alter the highway wards, in which Tim^r. Ames Stone is surveyor -
15. To see if the Town will make some repairs upon the poor house -
16. To see if the town will instruct the overseers of the poor to sue the account against Capt. Jesse Godnow to do or act &c.
17. To see if the town discount certain taxes that may be offered for that purpose
18. To see if the town will alter the mode of collecting taxes
19. To see if the town will widen the road near Henry Vos's house, by blasting the rocks on said road, To do or act &c.
20. To see if the town will give to each school District the proportion of school money assessed against each respectively - And also to see if the town will choose a Committee to examine Teachers, visit schools &c to do or act &c.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the meetinghouse of the said First Parish, two sabbaths at least before the time for holding said meeting
