10. Granted six hundred & sixty five dollars for repairs on the north road -

13. Chose Thos. Stearns, Paul Walker, & Saml. Jones a com. to carry into effect the objects of this Article -
14. Voted that the subject of this Article be left to the Selectmen
15. Voted that the Overseers of the Poor make all necessary repairs upon the Poor house
Voted that the Committee on the Hears make all necessary repairs
16. Ordered that the Overseers of the Poor collect an amount of the Town Against Cap^t. Jesse Goodnow -
17. No discounts of taxes allowed at this meeting
18. Voted to pass over this Article
19. Voted that the highway Surveyor of the district make the repairs contemplated by this Article -
20. Chose Thos. Stearns, Nahum Thompson and Lyman Howe the committee referred to in this Article - Then took up the 6th Art. & granted the sum of 460 Dollars including fuel for the Winter Schools & 215 dollars for Summer Schools to be distributed as it was last year - Voted to dissolve the meeting
