Greeting -

L. S. In the name of the Commonwealth

of Massachusetts, you are required to Not-
ify & warn the Inhabitants of Sudbury qualified
to Vote in Elections to meet at the meeting house
of the first Parish in said Town on Monday the
ninth day of November next, it being the second
Monday of said month, at twelve o'clock Mid-
-ian, To bring in to the Selectmen their votes for
a Governor, Lieutenant Governor of this Common-
-wealth, and six senators, all on one ballot for
the district of Middlesex - And also to bring
their votes for a representative of said Commonwealth
