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To Samuel Puffer Junr. Constable of the
Town of Sudbury in said County. Greeting.

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
you are hereby required to notify the inhabitants of the Town
of Sudbury qualified to vote in Elections and town affairs to
meet at the Meeting house of the first Parish in said
Sudbury on Monday the first day of March next at
twelve o'clock Meridian there and there to act on the
following articles viz. Polls for choice of Town Clerk & Selectmen opened
at one o'clock P.M.

1. To choose a Moderator.
2. To bring in there votes for County Treasurer & Register of Deeds
for the County of Middlesex.
3. To choose Town Clerk Selectmen and all other necessary
town officers for the ensuing year.
4. To grant a suitable sum of money for repairing
highways and bridges.
5. To hear and act on all reports.
6. To see if the town will take any measures to purchase
a fine Engine.
7. To discount certain taxes that may be offered for
that purpose.
8. To see if the town will accept of a road laid out
by the Selectmen on the petition of Israel Hunt & others
And you are directed, to serve this warrant by posting
up an attested copy thereof at the meeting house aforesaid
two sabbaths at least before the time for holding
said meeting. Hereof fail not and make return
of this warrant with your doings thereon to ourselves
at the time and place of meeting as aforesaid.
