

March 1841

At a legal Meeting of the Inhabitants of Sudbury held on Monday the first day of March D. 1841.

At the request of the Town Clerk voted that verbal amendment be made in the 2^d & 5. articles of the warrant & that the warrant be accepted with those amendments. The town then acted upon the articles of said warrant in the following manner viz.

1. Chose John Hunt Moderator.

2. Gave in their votes for County Treasurer and a Register of Deeds for said County of Middlesex as follows
For County Treasurer.

Steaman Buttrick had one hundred and forty three votes

Albert H. Nelson had sixty three votes.

For Register of Deeds

William F. Stone had twenty five votes

William E. Parmenter had one hundred and thirty three votes—

Voted to adjourn this meeting to Monday the 8th instant at half an hour past twelve o'clock Noon—

Voted to accept of the adjournment—
