LS In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
you are directed to notify the inhabitants of said town
qualified to vote in Elections and town affairs to meet
at the Meeting-house of the first Parish in said town
on Monday the fifth day of April next at twelve o'clock
Meridian then and there to act on the following articles
viz.

1. To bring in to the Selectmen their written votes
for three County Commissioners and two Special
Commissioners for the County of Middlesex.
2. To choose a Moderator.
3. To choose all necessary town officers not
chosen at March meeting.
4. To grant money for the support of the
poor the present year.
5. To grant money for the Summer and Winter
schools and order how the same shall be distributed.
6. To grant money to pay the Treasurer & Assessors
7. To hear and act on all reports of Committees
8. To grant money to pay accounts allowed by the
Committee on accounts.
9. To grant money for incidental expenses.
10. To grant money to pay damages and for making
the road laid out by the County Commissioners
on the petition of James Moore & others.
11. To see if the town will grant money to pay
for a new hearse to do or act as the town
shall think proper
12. To see if the town will discontinue a certain
piece of town way near Otis Puffers in the
north part of the town
