6. Granted twenty Dollars to pay Assessors and ten dollars to pay Treasurer
 7. Voted to accept the report of the Committee on Accounts
 8. Granted one hundred and forty one Dollars and fifty five cents to pay accounts allowed by the Committee on accounts
 9. Granted one hundred Dollars for incidental expenses
 10. Granted three hundred two Dollars and eighty six cents to pay damages and for making the Road petitioned for by James Moore and others
 11. Granted fifty Dollars to repair the Hearse.
 12. Voted to pass over this art.
 13. Granted thirty five Dollars to pay Elijah Bacon and John Eaton for Road.
 14. Voted that Aaron Hunt and others have liberty to move the wall now standing North of Concord, Smith & Hunts Tombs to a line ranging with the front of said Tombs thence from the corner of Concord's Tombs to near the post in the Bars North of the Schoolhouse with liberty to build a Road on the south side of said wall.
