L.S. To Thomas Stearns Jun. Constable of
L.S. the town Sudbury in said County Greeting.

L.S. In the name of the Commonwealth of
Massachusetts you are directed to notify the in-
habitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to
vote in town affairs to meet at the Meeting
house of the first Parish in said town on Mon-
day the twenty third day of August inst. at three
o'clock in the afternoon then and there to act on
the following articles viz.

1st. To choose a Moderator.

2^d To see if the town will choose an agent or
agents to oppose the Road petitioned by for
by Israel Hunt and others before the County
Commissioners at their meeting the second day of
Sept. next to view said route as prayed for in
said petition, to do or act as the town shall
think proper.

3^d To see what measures the town will take
to settle a Bill brought against them by
Mr. Hagg for damages sustained by him in
overturning his wagon near the house of Mr.
Lewis Brigham in April last in consequence
of the Road being out of repair to do or act as
the town shall think proper.

And you are directed to serve this warrant
by posting up an attested copy thereof at the
Meeting house aforesaid two Sabbaths at least
before the time for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this
warrant with your doings thereon to ourselves at
the time and place of meeting as aforesaid.
