At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the twenty third day of August A. 1841 the articles preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner

1st. Chose Abel B. Jones Moderator.

2nd Chose Paul Walker, Reuben Haynes and Thomas B. Battels Agents to meet the County Commissioners the second day of Sept. next and oppose the new Road petitioned for by Israel Hunt and others and voted to instruct said Agents to view any other route or routes that may be shown them and report at some future meeting.

3^d Voted that the Selectmen settle the subject of this article as they shall think is for the best interest of the town.

Then voted to dissolve the meeting
