L.S. of the town of Sudbury in said County Greeting
L.S. In the name of the Commonwealth of Mass-
achusetts you are directed to notify the inhabitants
of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs
to meet at the Meetinghouse of the first Parish in
said town on Monday the twentyfifth day of October inst.
at one o'clock P.M. then and there to act on the following
articles viz.

1. To choose a Moderator
2. To see if the town will choose an agent or agents to
oppose before the County Commissioners the Roads
petitioned for by, Woyse Smith, Nathan Pratt, Ezekiel
S. Brown, & others.
3. To choose a Committee to let out building of the
pieces of new highway as prayed for by Enoch Ridder
& others And also to choose a Committee to let out the
building of the Road laid out on petition of Israel
Hunt & others.
4. To see if the town will allow to Capt. Wm. Brigham
& Asa Jones additional damages for Road located
through their land on petition of Israel Hunt & others.
5. To see if the town will give Mr. Plymton liberty to
build a Gateway at the Burying Ground.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by
posting up an attested copy thereof at the Meeting
house aforesaid two Sabbaths at least before the time
for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not, and make return of this
warrant with your doings thereon, to ourselves
at the time and place of meeting as aforesaid.
