By virtue of the within warrant I have notified the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at the time and place and for the purposes therein mentioned.

At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the twenty fifth day of October A. D. 1841. the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner

1. Chose John Hunt Moderator
2. Voted to choose five agents to oppose the Road petitioned for by Morse Smith & others, and chose C. G. Cutler John Hunt, Israel Haynes, Levi Smith, & Daniel Puffer then voted to choose two agents to oppose the Road petitioned for by Nathan Pratt & others and chose Asher Goodnow Esq. & Col. Ephraim Moore for said agents, then voted that Asher Goodnow Esq. & Col. Ephraim Moore oppose the alterations petitioned for by Ezekiel S. Brown & others.
3. Voted to choose a committee of three to let out the making of the Road petitioned for by Enoch Kidder & others and chose Abel B. Jones, Charles Garry & John Hunt for said committee, then voted to choose a committee of three to let out the making of the Road petitioned for by Israel Hunt & others. and chose Capt. Wm. Brigham, Samuel Jones, & Israel Haynes for said committee.
4. Voted to pass over this article.
5. Voted to choose a committee of three to give Mr. Plymton liberty to build a Gate way at the Burving Ground on such terms as they shall think proper and chose Thomas Stearns Asher Goodnow & Wm. Maynard. James Moore Town Clerk. John Hunt Moderator.
