

December 1841

At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the sixth day of Dec. A. 1841. the articles in the preceeding warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner viz.

1. Chose Capt. William Brigham Moderator.

Then voted to pass over the 2. and 3. articles for the present and take up the 4th.

4. Discounted to Samuel Puffer Jun. the following taxes The Heirs of David Baldwins tax of 52 cts. Francis Merans tax of \$ 1.25 Wm Durants tax of \$ 1.25. to Nahum Goodnow Jun. Charles Wheelers tax of \$ 2.32.

Then voted to take up the 2. article.

2. Voted to pass over this article.

3. It was moved to see if the town would choose a Committee of five one from each school district who are not members of the first Parish to confer with a committee of said Parish and see on what terms they will relinquish a part of their Meeting house for a town house and report at March meeting and passed in the Negative.

It was moved to reconsider said vote and passed in the Negative.

Then voted that this meeting be dissolved.
