4. Granted the sum of Twelve hundred Dollars for repairs of Highways and Bridges the present year.
Price of labor 12 Cts. per hour.
Then voted that the Assessors give the Surveyors warrants and that the Surveyors give each person legal notice to work, and in case of neglect then the Surveyors to collect the money of each delinquent and cause the same to be expended in labor on the Road in their respective wards.
5. Voted to accept the Settlement of Selectmen with the Treasurer and ordered the same to be Recorded then voted to accept the Report of the Overseers of the Poor.
6. Voted that the manner of warning Town Meetings be so far altered that a copy of the warrant be posted up at each of the Meetinghouses in said town, then voted that the Selectmen provide a place for holding said Meetings the present year.
7. Voted to pass over this Article.
8. Voted to pass over this Article.
9. Voted that the Treasurer borrow money and pay Joel Parmenter the damages allowed by the Selectmen for a Road laid out through his land.
10. Voted to pass over this Article.
