In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are directed to notify the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at the Meetinghouse of the first Parish in said on Monday the fourth day of April next at twelve o'clock Meridian there and there to act on the following articles:

- 1 To choose a Moderator
- 2 To choose a Constable & Collector and fill all vacancies in the town offices
- 3 To grant money for the support of the Poor the present year
- 4 To grant money for the summer and winter schools and order how the same shall be distributed
- 5 To grant money to pay the Assessors & Treasurer the present year.
- 6 To grant money to pay the damages and for making the Road laid out by the Selectmen on petition of Israel Hunt & others.
- 7 To grant money to pay for making the straightings in the Road petitioned for by Enoch Kidder & others.
- 8 To hear and act on all Reports of Committees
- 9 To grant money to accounts allowed by the Committee on accounts
- 10 To grant money for incidental expenses
- 11 To see if the town will direct the Assessors to take ^{the} invoice of personal property the present year, and also to alter the time of assessing the taxes to do or act as the town shall think proper.
- 12 To see if the town will choose a Committee to oppose the Roads petitioned for by Horace Heard Levi Smith & others.
